Homeless Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All shelters are still open • Hotels are used for isolation purposes for homeless clients presenting with active COVI-19 symptoms who meet welfare requirements

Partnership for Maternal and Child Health of NNJ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community health workers are still taking referrals • Early childhood specialists are providing support to caregivers via phone • Still providing educational webinars and direct service support

Haven	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Physical building is closed• Providing daily support counseling, mentoring and tutoring via ZOOM calls• Looking into providing youth with laptops and mobile hotspots that need these resources• Conducting an online cooking contest
Northeast NJ Legal Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Still serving clients, but all three physical sites are closed• Accepting referrals
WomenRising	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Staff working from home• 24/7 hotline is still operational• Still providing food referrals to Old Bergen• Clients have the option to engage in telephone or video calls to engage in counseling services• Client who do not wish to engage in telehealth will still receive checkup calls from their counselors
HC Department of Family Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open from 7am to 2pm for emergency issues such as housing• Any existing cases will not terminate due to any recertification or redetermine date in effect prior to the crisis
